Welcome to first grade! I hope you are enjoying your summer vacation. I am looking forward to seeing you in September for an exciting year of school. Here are a few things you will need for first grade.

Personal Use: Please put your name on these items before dropping them off.

- 1 box of basic 24 crayons
- 1 box of traditional color washable standard markers
- 1 box of traditional color washable thin markers
- 1 fine tip black Sharpie marker
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 pencil box (large enough to fit your crayons, markers, colored pencils, scissors, and glue)*
- 1 pencil eraser
- 1 pair of child size scissors
- 4 black Expo dry-erase markers
- 1 small whiteboard eraser
- 3 plain plastic pocket folders (no brads on the inside) (1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green)
- 2 marble composition books for journal writing (Mead Primary Journal)**



- 2 marble composition books for spelling (Mead Primary Composition)***



- 1 white one-inch vinyl three-ring binder with a clear front pocket

1 set of headphones with a straight jack input

Community Use:

2 packages of #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils)

6 large glue sticks

2 large boxes of tissues

2 containers of Wet Ones Antibacterial Hand Wipes

2 containers of Clorox or Lysol wipes

1 small container of liquid soap

Girls - 1 box of zip-closeable **gallon size** storage bags

Boys - 1 box of zip-closeable **sandwich size** storage bags

Please drop these items off 1 to 2 weeks before the first day of school with your name on each personal item and the community items in a separate bag labeled with your name. Please do not put your name on the pencils.

*Sometimes a non-pencil box works best, as long as it is under three-inches tall and no longer than 15 inches.
